Practical Experience

Bible study and visitation. Weekend missionary work experience in local churches and outreach areas of NSW. Students will work two by two in a rotating schedule for one month at a time.

International Students

International students with visa restrictions of 3 months, will attend for the first three months and complete the remaining classes by DVD.

Your "Gospel Workers" Unit test supervisor will supervise your work in month 4. After finishing an additional month of practical experience in your local area, as well as completing and passing all remaining testing, you will be eligible for a graduation certificate.

Prerequisites

- Church member of the Seventh Day Adventist Reform Movement
- Good command of the English Language
- Must finish homework on the book *Gospel Workers* before opening class (by 15 January, 2018).
- Tools: a laptop computer with Bible and Spirit of Prophecy and word processing software.
- No latecomers; all must commit to finishing the entire program.

Application must be returned no later than 1st November, 2017.

Homework

It is a requirement that all attendees must finish homework on the book *Gospel Workers*. This entails reading the book once through, then studying each section in-depth.

After studying each section, there will be a supervised test administered by someone in your local area, designated by the training coordinator. Tests must be completed and sent to the office on or before Monday, the 15th January, 2018.

It is strongly recommended that you obtain a copy of the book immediately and read it while your application is being processed.
